In this one day creative workshop you'll learn how to use needle-felting and hand embroidery to create a stunning and one-off piece of artwork. Using a barbed needle to fuse different fibres



together, needle-felting produces a tactile, textured surface on which to stitch and bead. An easy-to-learn craft suitable for any experience level.
